 - H. Billiards training clinics. In an effort to recruit more players, we conducted about 5 weeks' worth of training clinics. We may do this again in about 6 months. All together, 19 people showed up: 5 men and 14 ladies. It was very well received.
 - I. Excessive use of chalk and table cleaning. I have received several complaints about the excessive chalk on the cloth when players show up to play. There is nothing that I can do about that other than to keep reminding players to clean the tables when you finish playing. Going forward, the home team players are responsible for cleaning the tables that they played on during their match. There is generally enough time between matches to brush the tables and wipe down the wooden portion of the rails. Brush the tables in one direction from the head to the foot (in the direction of the break). Brushing and wiping the wood only takes 2 or 3 minutes and will help keep the tables in good condition. Also, when chalking your cue stick, please do not chalk it over the table.
 - J. Table vacuuming. The cleaning team is now vacuuming the tables once per week on Sundays. They do it twice per week when they can.
